RE: HSC Advanced English Study Day

Students in the HSC Advanced English class have the opportunity to attend an HSC study day, 'Windows of Opportunity'. Students will attend three sessions covering the Modules for their HSC. Date: Monday, 16th March, 2009

Departure Time: Parents are asked to transport students to Bombaderry railway station by 4:10 p.m. on Sunday, 15th March. Students will travel by train from Bombaderry to Central with Mr. Rafidi.

Clothing: Students must be in full school uniform for the Study Day. Appropriate casual wear is permitted on Sunday.

Accommodation: We will book into the Sydney Railway Square Youth Hostel for the night of Sunday 15th March. We will eat dinner in Sydney.

On Monday, we will walk to the venue on Pitt Street and back to Central Station afterwards.

Equipment: Students should bring their own towel. The Youth Hostel provides linen. They must be equipped with stationary to take notes from the lectures.

Transport: Student concession cards will be provided by the office.

Expenses: The school is able to cover the cost of the lectures as well as accommodation costs (this includes breakfast on Monday morning). Students are asked to pay for their own transport via train and other meals for the duration of the excursion.
