- Leg ropes must be used.
- A wetsuit is recommended to be worn.
- The wearing of surf helmets is to be encouraged.
- Broad spectrum (SPF30+), water resistant sunscreen is to be worn & reapplied regularly throughout the day.
- When not competing competitors must wear a hat & shirt for sun protection.
