Dear Parents,

RE: Visual Arts/Photography Excursion

Students in the Year 11 & 12 Visual Arts and Year 11 Photography classes will be traveling to Sydney to view exhibitions and participate in study tours.

- When: Tuesday 31st March – Thursday 2nd April, 2009
Leave School: At 3:20 p.m. on Tuesday afternoon.
Return to School: At approximately 8.00 p.m. on Thursday 2nd April on the same bus with the AICES swimmers. Should there be a change in times after that, students will ring you.
What to Wear: Full school uniform required for Gallery visits. Students will change into casual clothes (no thongs, singlet tops, bare mid-riffs or board shorts) for the trip to Sydney and will require a change of clothes for dinner and movies on Wednesday night.
Where will we Stay: We will be staying at the Railway Square YHA in rooms of 4 and 6. Students from SAS have stayed at this location on many excursions in the past and it provides safe and comfortable accommodation that is in easy traveling distance to our places of interest.
Transport: Students will be traveling by bus to Bomaderry station, catching the train to Sydney on 31st March and returning from Sydney on Thursday 2nd April by bus. Students will need to bring their Student Concession Card (issued by the school).
Expenses: Accommodation including breakfasts, entry to exhibitions and bus transport home, have been paid for through school. Students will require up to \$80 spending money for other meals, movie and train tickets.

Students will find the excursion highly beneficial for their senior Visual Arts and Photography classes. The excursion will enable students to see Art Express (the senior Year 12 Visual Arts exhibition of students works from last year), see various exhibitions & have study tours that will relate to Case Studies. We will also be visiting the Australian Centre of Photography where students will have a tour and learn about various courses available to them. Mr. Campbell will be running a workshop for students on the Wednesday afternoon which will allow students to use the city landscape as the focus for photography and art. We will be visiting the Museum of Contemporary Art before returning home, again to enable us to study works relative to our Case Studies.
