Academic Scholarships for 2010

General information

In order to support and reward academic excellence, Shoalhaven Anglican School will offer academic scholarships to select applicants. Generally, academic scholarships are provided to students considered to have high academic potential and who can be expected to benefit from, as well as contribute to, the broad life of the School. In 2010, the following Academic Scholarships will be offered:

For entry into Year 7, 2010	Headmaster's Scholarship – open to current Shoalhaven Anglican School Year 6 students
	Shoalhaven Anglican School Scholarship – open to students from both outside the School and to current Shoalhaven Anglican School Year 6 students
For entry into Year 9, 2010	Shoalhaven Anglican School Scholarship – open to students from both outside the School and to current Shoalhaven Anglican School Year 8 students
For entry into Year 11, 2010	Shoalhaven Anglican School Senior Scholarship – open to students from both outside the School and to current Shoalhaven Anglican School Year 10 students

Successful scholarship holders will be expected to demonstrate outstanding academic progress and potential. They will also be expected to participate in a broad range of School activities as part of their scholarship.

The School will base decisions about scholarships on results gained by students who have successfully completed the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) Co-operative Scholarship Testing Program (CSTP). Students may also be required to attend a scholarship interview with the Headmaster and/or the deputy Head.

Students will be required to sit for the CSTP examination to be held from **8:45am – 12:15pm (approximately)** on **9th May 2009** at the School. More details will be sent to candidates closer to the examination date. The cost of the CSTP examination is **\$90.00** (including GST).

Results of the scholarship examination will be given to the School. Offers of scholarships will be made in June 2009.

Tenure of Scholarships

Scholarships will normally cover tuition fees for the duration of a student's remaining period of Secondary School tuition, *subject to on-going satisfactory academic performance* and involvement in the wider life of the School. If this performance is satisfactory, the scholarship will be renewed each year until the completion of Year 12. Scholarships will be reviewed each year in Term 4.

Registration for Scholarship testing

Enrolment for the CSTP may only be completed on-line. Visit the School's Website Scholarship page (www.sas.nsw.edu.au/scholarships) to complete the registration. Please note that all registrations must be complete by **5:00pm Thursday 9th April 2009**. Registrations after this date will incur a late fee. Students who have not completed registration prior to the examination will not be permitted to enter the examination room.
